JOB CORPS HALL OF FAME INCLUDES FOUR AWARDS:

HALL OF FAME | 1 RECIPIENT

- Job Corps graduate with five-plus years of career experience.
- Obtained educational and employment-related achievements in the area of their Job Corps career training.

SUCCESSFUL GRADUATE | 3 RECIPIENTS

- Job Corps graduates who completed the program within the last two years.
- Successfully begun their career path, including an increase in salary or promotion.

RISING STAR | 2 RECIPIENTS

Current Job Corps students who are committed to career readiness and demonstrated leadership qualities through career training and dorm leadership positions, participation in SGA, and other on-campus clubs/activities.

STAFF MOTIVATOR OF THE YEAR | 1 RECIPIENT

One Job Corps staff member, from campus leader or instructor to Outreach and Admissions staff member and every role in between, who is committed to supporting students in their career and education training, leadership, and overall well-being.

Each center is welcome to submit one nomination per category. Submissions should come from the Center Director's office. Self-nominations are not permitted at this time.

Award recipients will be inducted into the Job Corps Hall of Fame class at an in-person ceremony during the Leadership Summit in December and will serve as advocates for Job Corps by sharing their experiences about the program's benefits.
