NEW JOB CORPS AND NAVSEA PARTNERSHIP RESOURCES

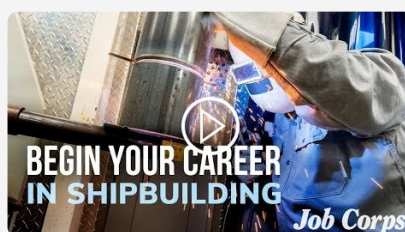

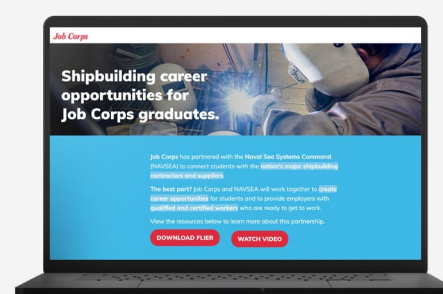
